Shackleford Wild Horse and Shelling Safari – Take a 15-minute ferry ride over to Shackleford Banks and the southern portion of the Cape Lookout National Seashore. There you will be introduced to the Wild Horses of Shackleford. This herd is descended from Spanish Mustangs that were shipwrecked here roughly 500 years ago, and still survive as one of the last group of wild horses in the US. You will help your guide track the horses and get up close and personal for a rare experience with nature that you'll never forget. Bring your camera for pictures that will forever remind you of this amazing place and its fascinating inhabitants. After the tour, you can spend the whole day on Shackleford and catch the ferry back whenever you're ready, and you can even bring your chairs and coolers! – Shackleford is well known as one of the best shelling destinations on the East Coast. Scenic Nature Cruise - This 1 1/4 hour trip provides a more scenic and slower paced ride. Shaded seats are available as you REMAIN on the boat during this memorable cruise. This scenic trip shows you the entire 3 miles of the Beaufort waterfront including Blackbeard's house, an operating menhaden fish factory, Cape Lookout lighthouse (from a distance), Blackbeard's shipwreck site (Queen Anne's Revenge), Fort Macon, Radio Island and Duke Marine Lab. Many birds may be sighted including Gulls, Pelicans, Ibis, Blue Heron, Egrets and Osprey . Wild, shipwrecked mustangs may be seen - the only tour that completely circles Carrot Island, Horse Island, Sand Dollar Island, Bird Shoals and Town Marsh while traveling past part of Shackleford Banks in search of these mustangs and coastal wildlife.
